This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections for Bal Vatika is restricted to 03 (01 each for Bal Vatika I,II & III respectively). Further, the total number of sections for classes 1st to 12th shall be restricted to 14 only out of which not more than 1/3rd sections shall be used for senior secondary level. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of 500 sq ft and greater in dimension.
2	The school is not covered by 6ft height boundary wall from all sides. The work is still under construction with building material lying in the campus. Further, the school has not made any safety arrangements during the construction work which is under progress for ramp, boundary wall and at building block itself. School has not completed the construction work for boundary wall, ramp and building. School is directed to make boundary wall to 06 ft all over the school and upload the compliance within 03 months.
3	All the three science labs for senior secondary level have still not been developed and arranged with proper safety measures and recommended infrastructure as per SoPs (circular no 11/2022) and Board guidelines. The labs have no emergency exit, exhaust

	fans, plastic stools for seating arrangements etc. The plastic items are not recommended in labs due to chemicals and heating facilities, School has not arranged and developed the labs as per guidelines. School is directed to make safety arrangements as per bye laws and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
4	Library is not arranged properly. The books are randomly placed in the racks without any categorization. The present arrangement of books is temporary and not recommended for smooth library functioning. School has not followed the SoPs and guidelines to develop and upgrade the library as per norms. School is directed to upgrade the library as per circular no 11/2022 and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
5	The Composite Science lab has not been upgraded and arranged as per Board guidelines and SoPs for labs (Circular no 11/2022). No exhaust fans, emergency exit and safe gas connection available. Further, plastic stools are still available which are not safe due to heating facility in the lab. School has not followed the board guidelines and developed the lab accordingly. 6	The side railing to the ramp at the school entrance are not proper and appropriate as per recommended guidelines. The railings have wide gaps and the hand rails are at far distance making it temporary and not useful for the wheelchair bound person. The ramps should have proper handrail for its use and be made as per the circular no 05/2023. The side railing to the ramp at the school entrance are not proper and appropriate as per recommended guidelines. 7	The CwSN toilets are still not arranged as per the board guidelines. The toilets have steep ramp at the entrance which is not convenient for the wheelchair bound users. School has not arranged the facilities for the CwSN even after the IC rejection. Compliance on CwSN infrastructure as per Board's guidelines be complied and uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 month.
8	School is residential and the residential complex for students is not within the school campus but constructed in adjacent property separated by school boundary wall. Board has issued guidelines for safety and proper security arrangement for residential complex in the schools. No specific arrangements and compliance of guidelines has been made by the school. Compliance be uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 months.
9	The electric wires and poles are still in the school campus which is not safe for the students and the staff. Further, the school has provided no documents from electricity deptt during the review for removal of all electric lines from the school campus. Hence school should first make proper safety arrangements and is directed to remove the electric poles and keep all safety provisions within 03 months.
10	School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from CoE, CBSE, Ajmer and shall upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye - Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
